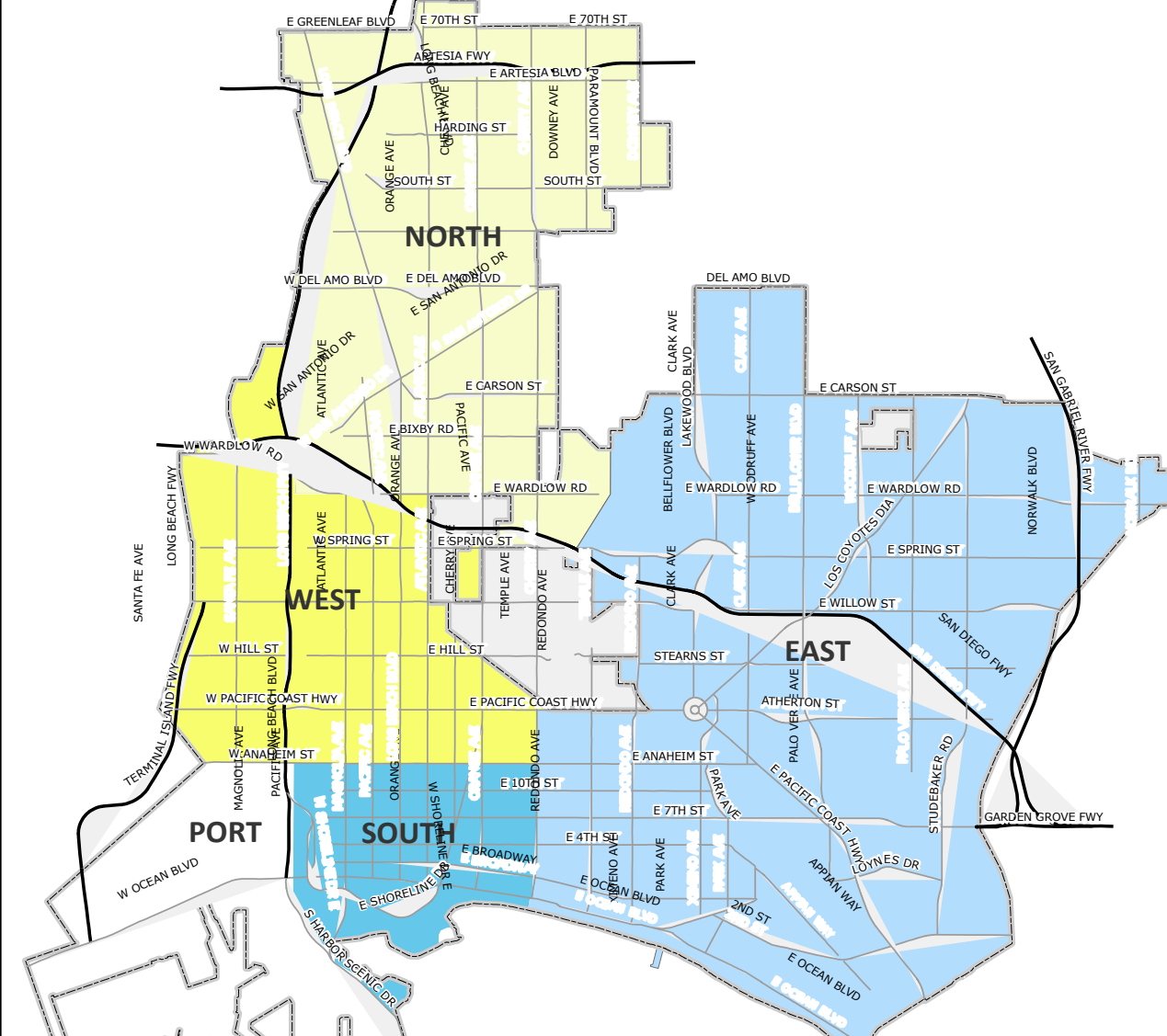

Homeless Outreach

- 9,350 Contacts with PEH
- 40% Increase in Contracts Resulting in Housing
- 441 Contacts Resulting in Temporary Housing
- 371 Contacts Resulting in Permanent Housing
 - 54% Increase
- 1,068 Clean-up Operations Throughout the City



Officer Position Enhancements – Outreach and Prevention



Neighborhood Safety Bike Team (NSBT)

- 11.0 FTE Measure A offset
- 5.0 FTE General Fund offset
- 4 NSBT Officers per Division but with a Citywide lens on high-need areas.



One-time Funds: Response & Communications - \$2.9 Million

One-time Funds: Los Angeles River Outreach Program

Outreach & Clean-Up Along the Riverbed \$2.4 Million – over two years

- Overtime equivalent to four Police Officers & one Police Sergeant in the Quality-of-Life Team
- Collaboration with the Public Works - Clean Team & Health Department Outreach Workers
- Acquisition of 4x4 vehicles to access riverbeds
