RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to receive and file a presentation regarding an update on the City's response to the *Grants Pass v. Johnson* Decision (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

On August 12, 2024, the City Manager released a memo to the Mayor and Members of City Council outlining the City's response to the *Grants Pass v. Johnson* Supreme Court decision, including a commitment to provide an update presentation to the Mayor and the City Council.

This update presentation is intended to review the City's approach, assess qualitative and quantitative service data, and summarize further information on how this Supreme Court decision has impacted the City's response to homelessness. More information can be found in the memorandum dated May 12, 2025(attached).

This matter was reviewed by Principal Deputy City Attorney Erin Weesner-McKinley and by Budget Development Officer Jennifer Rodriguez on April 3, 2025.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action to receive and file a presentation on a six-month update to the City's response to the *Grants Pass v. Johnson* decision is requested on May 20, 2025, to ensure timely reporting of actions taken within the first six months, from August 2024 to February 2025.

FISCAL IMPACT

Implementation of any future recommendations may have a fiscal impact and would be determined based on the scope of directions received. This recommendation has no staffing impact beyond the normal budgeted scope of duties and is consistent with existing City Council priorities.
