A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF LONG BEACH ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 FUNDED BY SENATE BILL 1: THE  
ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (“SB 1”), the Road Repair and Accountability Act  
of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the California Legislature and signed  
into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal  
transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that  
will ensure the residents of the City of Long Beach, California (“City”) are aware of the  
projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed  
each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive  
funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (“RMRA”), created by SB  
1 by resolution, which must include the scope, location, schedule, and useful life  
information of each proposed project, and the use of a Pavement Management System to  
develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority  
and cost-effective projects; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive an estimated Thirteen Million Three Hundred  
Thousand Dollars (\$13,300,00) in RMRA funding for part of the proposed Capital  
Improvement Program (“CIP”) work in FY 26 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City's street paving program is guided by the citywide  
Infrastructure Investment Plan (“IIP”) and the Pavement Management Program (“PMP”), in  
coordination with other CIP projects, and with consideration for the most efficient use of  
public funds; and
