Precious Lamb provides faith-based, full-day, quality education and care to children 18 months to 5 years old experiencing homelessness at no cost to the parent. Through early education that promotes faith-building and school readiness, we seek to foster permanent positive change in our families.

*Christ-centered care for children experiencing homelessness that builds faith and promotes school readiness; and

*A trusting learning environment for parents experiencing homelessness where individual growth fosters hopeful, healthy and permanent change

Through education, support and empowerment we hope to bring a sense of stability for children ages 18 months to 5 years old by offering a safe place to learn. We desire to be a tangible support system for young children and their families who are experiencing homelessness.

Pre-K: 8 students enrolled, all attend consistently 5 days a week

Preschool: 12 students enrolled, all attend consistently 5 days a week

Toddler: 12 students enrolled, all attend consistently 5 days a week

Currently have 6 full time, 3 part time

Student Drop Off:

Students are dropped off at the playground gate from 7:45 AM – 9:00 AM. Temperatures are checked, parents answer health check questions, and students wash their hands before playing on the playground.

Number of students on site each day:

Currently, there is an average of 30 students on site each day.
