Subject: Transfer of Funds: The Nonprofit Partnership

### RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation to increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$2,500, offset Fourth Council District One-time District Priority Funds transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to provide support to Long Beach Nonprofit Partnership for the annual Long Beach Gives Campaign; and,

Decrease appropriations in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$2,500 to offset a transfer to the City Manager Department.

### DISCUSSION

Long Beach Nonprofit Partnership is the fiscal sponsor of Long Beach Gives. Long Beach Gives is a one-day, citywide, online fundraising campaign to raise awareness of the exemplary work by nonprofit organizations making a difference in Long Beach. Council District 4 wishes to support individual nonprofit organizations doing work for the communities in the district while also supporting Long Beach Gives's campaign therefore, approval of this recommendation is requested.

This matter has been reviewed by Budget Manager Rebecca Bernstroff on March 24, 2025.

### FISCAL IMPACT

This recommendation requests the City Manager provide a contribution to Long Beach Nonprofit Partnership in support of the annual Long Beach Gives Campaign. The total appropriation increase of \$2,500 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of Fourth Council District One-time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. This recommendation is anticipated to require a minimal level of staff time beyond the budgeted scope of duties and is expected to have minimal impact on existing City Council priorities. There is no local job impact associated with this request.
