The Competition

The Stock Market Game, Created by The SIFMA Foundation

Description:

- Approximately 150 teams (750 individuals) across the country are divided into groups up to 5 students ages 12 to 18 years old
- Each team is provided approximately \$100,000 via a virtual brokerage account with which the team members will collectively invest that account into a diverse investment portfolio consisting of stock, mutual funds, and bonds

Game Objective:

- Invest in real time securities to grow the team's portfolio over the course of 10 – 12 weeks to the highest value possible.
- Top 5 Portfolio's go on to National Finals Competition to Compete for 1st , 2nd , & 3rd place prize money to be used to create a new or invest in existing brokerage account
