Subject: Funds Transfer to support Long Beach City College's Summerfest & Drone Show

### RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation to increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$10,000, offset by the Fifth Council District One-Time Priority Funds transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to provide a contribution of \$10,000 to Long Beach City College Foundation in support of their 2024 Summerfest & Drone show Event; and,

Decrease appropriations in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$10,000, to offset a transfer to the City Manager Department.

### DISCUSSION

Councilwoman Megan Kerr would like to contribute to Long Beach City College Foundation to support Long Beach City College's one-of-a-kind community festival showcasing all that Long Beach City College (LBCC) has to offer. The festival will be located at Veterans Memorial Stadium on July 27, 2024, from 4:00 PM – 9:00 PM. Hosting over five thousand guests, LBCC Departments will be on site with engaging activities to showcase their respective programs, with their STEM programs having a strong presence at the festival. All the proceeds from this event will support LBCC Students by providing scholarships and support towards STEM based programs. LBCC's purpose in this event is continuing innovative STEM programming to pave the way for the next generation of scientists, engineers, and innovators, ensuring a brighter future fueled by curiosity and discovery.

### FISCAL IMPACT

This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution of \$10,000 to Long Beach City College Foundation, in support of the event and organization as written above. The total appropriation increase of \$10,000 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of Fifth Council District One-time
