We're at a Crossroads for unhoused crisis. Cities like San Francisco and NYC on one end and Houston on the other. We need to be more like Houston. These are big ideas you may have already thought of. We need a long game strategy.

Homeless stages :

Home insecurity - means you have a place to live, but you're not secure in it.

Proposed Solution: provide resources to make you secure in the home where you live. Or provide a new secure home. Provide mental, health, job resources

Homeless - You have no home to live in. Maybe couch hopping, maybe a car, not in an actual home and space of your own.

Proposed Solution: provide resources to get you housed and keep you housed temporarily until there is a permanent solution provide mental, health, job resources.

Outside only - Don't want to be indoors. There are people who don't want to be inside. They would rather be outside and going into a shelter is not an option.

Proposed Solution: Create a space where people can pay to live in tents. provide mental, health, job resources.

Unhoused and publicly incapacitated (mentally and physically) - Can't care for themselves in the near and possibly indefinite future.

Proposed Solution: Set the criteria for unhoused and publicly incapacitated. Admit them. Try to find a next of kin if there is none they have to be admitted and stabilized to see if they can transition to one of the above three options.
