A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH RECOGNIZING MARCH 31ST AS
TRANSGENDER DAY OF VISIBILITY IN THE CITY OF
LONG BEACH AND RECOGNIZE THE CITY OF LONG
BEACH AS A SAFE CITY FOR TRANSGENDER PEOPLE
AND MEMBERS OF THE LBGTQIA+ COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, March 31st marks Transgender Day of Visibility, a day
dedicated to raising awareness about the experiences, achievements, and ongoing
struggles of transgender individuals; and

WHEREAS, Long Beach has long been a hub for LGBTQ+ culture and
activism, particularly along the Broadway Corridor, which has served as a cornerstone of
the community for decades; and

WHEREAS, home to numerous LGBTQ+ businesses, gathering spaces,
and historic advocacy efforts, the corridor represents the city's commitment to diversity
and inclusion; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach wants to be recognized as a safe city
for transgender people and the broader LGBTQIA+ community, with a firm commitment
to protecting transgender individuals from discrimination and harm to ensure access to
services, equal employment opportunities, and other essential resources remain secure
and uninterrupted;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
follows:

Section 1. Officially recognizing March 31st as Transgender Day of Visibility
in the City of Long Beach and recognize the City of Long Beach as a safe city for

transgender people and members of the LGBTQIA+ community, while also reaffirming the City of Long Beach's values as a safe and welcoming place for all members of the LGBTQIA+ community.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
