Recommendation

Adopt Specifications UD-25-214 and authorize the General Manager to execute all documents necessary to enter into an agreement, including any necessary subsequent amendments, with All American Asphalt to provide street repair services in an amount not to exceed \$5,500,000 for a period of one year, and to authorize the General Manager to exercise the option to renew for two additional one-year periods, with each renewal year subject to a not-to-exceed amount of \$660,000, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$6,820,000.

Executive Summary

On October 21, 2024, the Long Beach Public Utilities Department (LBUD) issued an Invitation to Bid for street repair services. The bid was advertised for three weeks on the Long Beach Buys e-bidding platform and published in print media. The scope of services includes, but is not limited to:

- Furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials for construction activities, including curbs, gutters, and sidewalks
- Asphalt-concrete paving, crushed miscellaneous base installation, excavation, grading, and earth fill placement
- Removal of concrete and bituminous surfaces, erosion control, and reconstruction of manhole frames, curb drains, and storm drain connector pipes
- Traffic striping, marking, signal conduit, and streetlight conduit installation
- Utility relocations, landscaping, irrigation, and emergency repair services as needed

On November 11, 2024, only one bid, from All American Asphalt, LBUD's current street repair services provider, was received and deemed to be in conformance to the specification requirements. Therefore, staff recommends awarding the street repair services contract to All American Asphalt in an amount not to exceed \$5,500,000.

Fiscal Impact

The cost to the Water, Sewer, and Gas funds will be incurred during FY 25 and FY 26 with the actual annual amounts unknown at this time but the total annual amount will not exceed the contract total of \$5,500,000. These costs are included in the Water, Sewer, and Gas fund's FY 25 Budget and financial projections.

- 32 prospective bidders downloaded the bid document

A Notice Inviting Bids (NIB) announcement was also included in the City's Purchasing Division's weekly update of Open Bid Opportunities, which is sent to local, minority-owned, and women-owned business groups.

- 1 bid was received on November 11, 2024 (see above matrix)

Local Business Outreach

In an effort to align with the City's outreach goal, Long Beach businesses are encouraged to submit bids for City contracts. The City's Purchasing Division also assists businesses with registering on the Long Beach Buys database to download ITBs.

- 13 Long Beach vendors were notified to submit bids
- 7 downloaded the plans and specifications
- 0 submitted a bid
