

RESOLUTION NO. RES-24-0046

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH C.S.I. PATROL SERVICE, INC. WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF UNARMED SECURITY SERVICES FOR BELMONT SHORE ON 2ND STREET FROM EAST TOLEDO TO LIVINGSTON DRIVE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2025

WHEREAS, the City Charter Section 1801 requires that contracts for City purchases be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder after a competitive bid process, but allows for awards without a competitive bid process when authorized by a Resolution adopted by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Belmont Shore Parking and Business Improvement Area Advisory Commission ("BSPBIAAC") is responsible for directing usage of the Belmont Shore Parking Fund; and

WHEREAS, the safety and security of the Belmont Shore neighborhood are a priority for the BSPBIAAC; and

WHEREAS, C.S.I. Patrol Service, Inc., is the current and only security service for the Belmont Shore area on 2nd Street since April of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the BSPBIAAC selected C.S.I. Patrol Service, Inc. due to their bicycle patrol service and experience patrolling similar business improvement areas, such as the Bixby Knolls Business Improvement Association and Downtown Long Beach Alliance; and

WHEREAS, the bicycle patrol services offered by C.S.I. Patrol Services, Inc., is essential for the Belmont Shore area and not offered by the Citywide security service vendor; and

WHEREAS, C.S.I. Patrol Services, Inc., was also first selected due to their proposal for bicycle patrol services coming in at a cost of 50% less than the Citywide security service vendor for the Belmont Shore area; and

WHEREAS, utilizing services from C.S.I. Patrol Service, Inc. will continue to help ensure public safety by deterring unwanted activity, providing public information assistance, and reducing additional Police Department resources that may be needed in the Belmont Shore area; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2024, the BSPBIAAC voted unanimously to continue private security services from C.S.I. Patrol Service, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract and any necessary subsequent amendments thereto with C.S.I. Patrol Service, Inc. for the purchase of unarmed security services for the Belmont Shore area on 2nd Street from East Toledo to Livingston Drive, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
