

RESOLUTION NO. RES-24-0042

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ON TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2024, TO SUBMIT TO A VOTE OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY ONE (1) BALLOT MEASURE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution No. RES-23-0169, duly call and provide for the holding of a Primary Municipal Election on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, to submit to a vote of the qualified electors of the City one (1) ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, the Primary Municipal Election was held in the City of Long Beach on Tuesday, March 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar duly canvassed the returns of the election and has transmitted the results to the City Clerk; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. A true and correct copy of the canvass of the votes cast for and against the ballot measure is attached as Exhibit "A" to this Resolution.

Section 2. The measure appeared on the ballot as follows:

A. Measure RW: Long Beach Hotel Worker Minimum Wage Increase. Shall the measure increasing the minimum wage for qualifying hotel workers from \$17.55 per hour to \$23.00 per hour on July 1, 2024, gradually increasing annually to \$29.50 per hour by July 1, 2028, applying cost of living increases starting July 1, 2029, clarifying "wages" and "service charges" paid to qualifying hotel workers and authorizing the Council to

make future amendments to the City's hotel worker minimum compensation standards, starting June 1, 2029, be adopted?

Section 3. It is determined and declared that at Primary Municipal Election, 39,949 votes were cast in favor of Measure RW and 35,234 votes were cast against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is hereby approved.


Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
