RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation to increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$500, offset by the Seventh Council District One-Time District Priority Funds, transferred from the Citywide Activities Department, to provide a contribution to Friends of the Long Beach Firefighters in support of the Cars and Clippers Cancer Fundraiser; and,

Decrease appropriations in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$500 to offset transfers to the City Manager Department.

DISCUSSION

Councilmember Uranga would like to provide support for St. Baldrick's mission of treating childhood cancer and supporting childhood cancer survivors.

St. Baldrick's works closely with leading oncologists to determine the most promising research to fund to make the greatest impact for children with Cancer. The Cars and Clippers event, held at Long Beach POA Park, will support that mission in Long Beach. A contribution will be provided to Friends of the Long Beach Firefighters in support of the Cars and Clippers event.

This matter has been reviewed by Budget Analyst Joe R. Guerrero on January 11, 2024.

FISCAL IMPACT

This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution of \$500 to Friends of the Long Beach Firefighters in support of the Cars and Clippers Cancer Fundraiser. The total appropriation increase of \$500 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of Seventh Council District One-time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. The requested action is anticipated to require a minimal level of staff hours beyond the normal budgeted scope of duties and expected to have minimal impact on existing City Council
